EDRA Sanctioned, helmets required

CAMP: Central Washington, between Coulee City and Hartline off Highway 2. There are services in Coulee City, 5 miles from camp at Big Wally's and Cenex.

From the East: Take Hwy 2 from Spokane 85 miles to mile post 197, you will see camp. From the West: Hwy 17 to Coulee City, go 2 miles to the Hwy 2 junction, take a right towards Spokane, camp is just past mile post 196.

Please bring clean hay. Camp and roads are nice and easy access for large rigs, lots of parking and easy access. Please 1 horse per corral and do not connect your corrals to each other for safety. No loose dogs. Map on website. www.coyoteridgeride.weebly.com.

TRAILS: A variety of trails, some technical with some rock but a lot that you can make really good time on with the gravel roads. With the wet spring we may be limited to the roads for safety reasons but nice footing. There will likely be a couple of shallow water crossings this time of year. One out vet check area for 25, 50 mile distances; there will be hay and water for horses and riders provided at the vet area.

GENERAL: All EDRA & PNER rules apply. Hoof protection strongly recommended. One out check area all distances will visit. Verizon has good service in the area, AT&T is intermittent.

FOOD: Dinner will be provided Saturday afternoon by chef Bill; \$10 for extra meals, awards to follow. If you don't come to ride, come volunteer; we'll feed ya good!

VETTING: Head vet is Dick Root, DVM, Mike Foss, DVM and Marlene Poe, DVM and vet students from WSU. Vetting to start at 3 pm Friday. Ride meeting will be Friday evening; ride criteria, loop information and maps will be available at sign in.
