Get Ready to Start Ready

Clinic and AGM

March 16-17th 2018

- **Friday March 16th** Arrive and set-up camp before noon. Meet and greet folks will help you pick parking and stall. Ride in warm-up (outdoor) arena
Check-in and get your lesson group assignment and schedule. Robin and Celena start lesson sessions at 12pm. A poster sized schedule will be posted in barn.

- **ALL RIDERS MUST WEAR HELMETS AT ALL TIMES WHEN MOUNTED ON EQUINES.**
This is an EDRA insurance required rule – noncompliance will result in expulsion without a refund.
All dogs must be leashed/kenneled at all times per insurance and fairgrounds rules
- **Bring fully charged smart phones for the GPS tracks lessons**
- Be prepared for cold/wet weather or warm/sunny weather

EDRA riding is in Harwood Pavilion 2 with warmup arena; stabling in barn 46 and meetings in Huck Fuller. Camping in the East Campground or the Pavilion Campground (*Horses are not allowed in the camp ground area – plan to haul gear to barn—trucks can pull up to barn*)
- Bring the following if possible: mounting block, portable saddle rack, manure fork, cart or wagon or wheel barrow or muck bucket

- **9am through 9pm** Find Sue in the Huck Fuller Building and have GPS tracks and aps downloaded so you are ready to go on Saturday. Thursday arrivals can get downloads on Thursday
- **12:00pm- 6:00pm** Horses and riders begin small group lessons in Harwood Pavilion arena. You may use the outdoor arena or round pen to warm up your horse. Audit as much as possible. See schedule below.
- **8am- 6:30pm** Jenn Pillow appointments (equine body work) in barn- bring \$70 cash to pay Jenn. See schedule below.
- **6:30-9pm** Huck Fuller Building
 - Introduce the equipment trailer raffle and sell tickets (\$10 or \$20) Bring money –you are going to WANT these prizes!
 - **Potluck** –EDRA will supply fried chicken & plates, cutlery, napkins, dish soap.
The meeting facility has a full service kitchen for everyone’s use

SADDLE TRIALS

Saddle Fit and Exchange

Bring saddles for people to try on their horses including quick rides in the outdoor arena – help someone with the great saddle search by sharing your saddle as a temporary demo – share what you like about it /type of horse it fits. Help people learn about saddles before they order one for their horse. Set-up time/space TBD by weather. **At outdoor arena weather permitting / in barn if inclement weather.**

BRING SADDLE RACKS PLEASE! BRING MOUNTING BLOCKS PLEASE!

Private saddle/tack sales permissible

**Depart Sunday morning –please clean your stalls before leaving/pick-up at your campsite –\$10 cleaning fees will be refunded if you clean stalls & campsites—
Check out between 7am and 9am at Barn.**

***BRING MANURE FORKS AND WHEEL BARROWS OR MUCK BUCKETS TO HAUL MANURE AND HAY FROM YOUR HORSE’S STALL to a muck bin**

CARTS AND WAGONS WILL MAKE IT EASIER TO HAUL YOUR HORSE’S GEAR and FEED INTO THE BARN –HORSES CANNOT BE ON GRASS BY TRAILERS IN CAMP GROUNDS

EDRA will be charged for all cleaning and damage to fairgrounds property – leave zero trace to save the treasury and ensure another clinic weekend next year!
