Equine participation is limited to the first 50 EDRA member horse registrations **PAID in full online—you do not have a slot until registration is paid**

If equine slots are not filled by EDRA members Feb 12th they will be opened for nonmembers until filled

Equine Registrations will not be refunded unless the slot can be refilled

- **Camping: \$50 for conference Friday – Sunday morning** (water and electrical hook-ups)
Additional \$25 for early arrival Thursday
If you don't want to camp there are hotel options nearby.
- **Stalls: \$60 for conference Friday – Sunday morning** includes bedding
Additional \$20 for early arrival Thursday
