### EDRA TYM Relay Info:

Teams are 2 horses and riders - each

horse/rider team completes 25 miles with  
the team completing 50 miles.

### LOCATION:

About halfway between Madras and Prineville,  
OR

From Madras: On hwy 97 traveling South, go  
left at the south end of Madras, onto SE Hwy 2b  
(Madras-Prineville Hwy). Travel 11.5 miles to  
ridecamp, on the left.

From Hwy 97, traveling North: in Terrebonne,  
turn right onto Smith Rock Way, go  
approximately 5.5 miles, turn left onto Lone  
Pine Rd, go approximately 6 miles to SE Hwy  
2b, turn left, go 2 miles, turn right onto  
driveway to ride camp.

Signs will be out on Hwy 2b.

### CAMP:

Large meadow with trees and some sage. Easy  
parking for big rigs.

### RULES:

**ALL EDRA/AERC RULES APPLY**

No open fires

Spread hay and manure

**ALL RIDERS WILL BE REQUIRED TO WEAR  
HELMETS WHEN MOUNTED - BOTH DAYS.**
