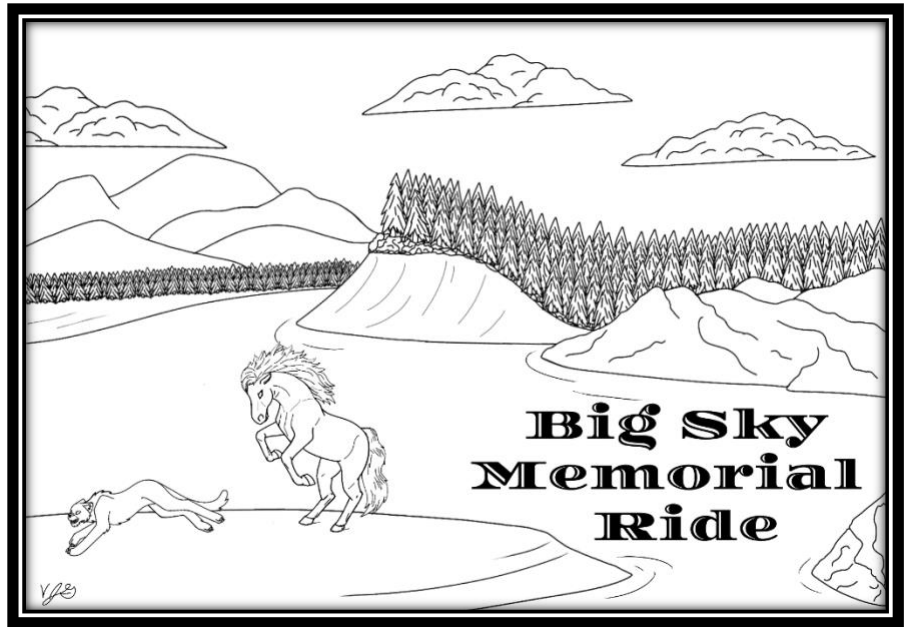


BIG SKY MEMORIAL RIDE

EDRA Ride

The Big Sky Memorial Ride is located next to beautiful Lake Kooacanusa in the great Kootenai Forest. The trails will consist mainly of forest service roads and single-track trails with beautiful views.



Anyone under 18 ride the 30, 50 and 75 free
No non-EDRA member rider fees
All EDRA Rules will be followed
Helmets required for all, while mounted
Hoof protection is recommended
All dogs must be leashed or confined

Directions: (GPS might take you off to Timbuktu)

From the intersection of Hwy 2 and 37 in Libby, travel north on Hwy 37, 13.5 miles. Just before Kootenai River Bridge make a left onto USF road 228 (paved) towards the Libby Dam Visitor Center (.5 of a mile pass mp 13). Go 8.3 miles and turn left (.3 of a mile pass mp 8) onto Jackson Creek Rd (gravel). Go about 1 mile, look for event signs and parking. Libby, MT is located just 3 hours NE of Spokane, WA.
